



Parking Permits

Faculty, staff, and student parking permits are available for purchase online at specified times. Personal permits must be paid for by the individual, not with university funds. Display your permit when parking in your regular lot or in your overflow lot if your primary lot is full. Be sure to register all permitted vehicles you will park on campus with PTS'. Return your permit for a prorated refund if you no longer need it. Do not give it or sell it to another person. On occasions when routine parking patterns are changed because of an event, parking staff will provide permit
